RULES

1. No Alcoholic beverages allowed on the Shooting Line and no Competitor shall shoot while under the influence of any alcoholic beverage.
2. RE-Entry- Old targets must be turned in at the same time re-entry target is bought.
3. Downed targets will be completed next relay. Inform Range Officer.
4. Targets must be pulled at end of relay if fired upon for score, except pistol, bench and musket which are two consecutive relays.
5. **Absolutely NO** loading, cleaning, or handling of sporting arms when range is called cold.
6. Range Officer will wear a bright orange vest and will assist you with any questions and problems.
7. All Juniors & Sub*juniors are required to be under adult supervision while on the shooting line.
8. Brushy Creek Muzzleloaders rules will be enforced. Relays will run 20 minutes.

PRIMITIVE RULES**1. Primitive matches will be held for 4 days this year- Wed.12pm - 5pm Thursday 12pm-5pm, Friday 10am-5pm, and Saturday 10am-5pm.**

2. Shooting from bag only. Round ball, open iron sights. Come prepared. No re-entry. Range rod may be used.

3. Club will furnish tinder and char-cloth for fire making.

4. No shooting aides (glasses with peeps, etc. Prescription glasses allowed).

5. Primitive dress encouraged - extra points

6. Hawk & Knife block to be used for shooters only during range open hours.

7. All campfires must be extinguished and fire pits covered at the break-up of camp.

8. All Children 15 and under must be under adult supervision during range open hours

O. PRIMITIVE (Primitive Dress encouraged but not required.)

P. ARCHERY (Held in Primitive) This competition will be held back by the primitive range. Primitive or re-curve bows only. No sites or compound bows allowed. The cost of the Archery Competition will be \$5.00 and is not included in any package plan.

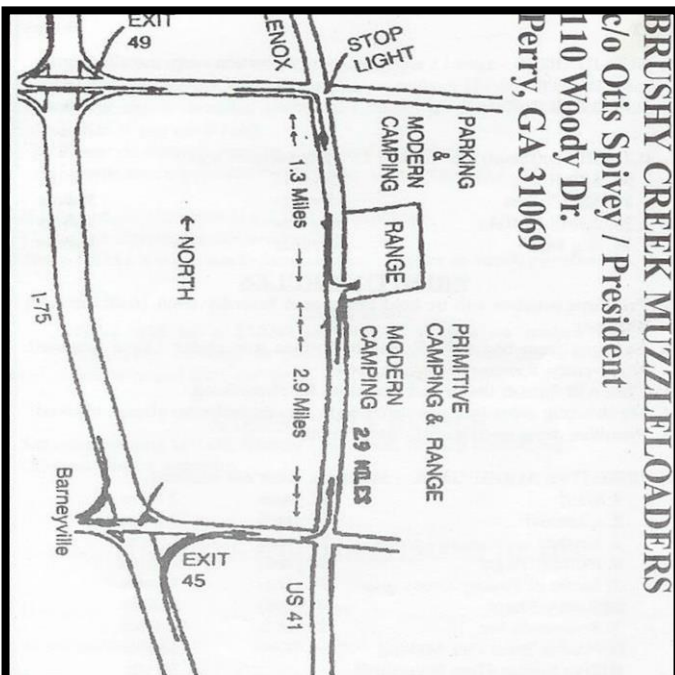
During Spring Rendezvous we will have a raffle drawing for 5 prizes donated by members and companies to be used to help Brushy Creek Muzzleloaders

Tickets will be \$5each or 5 for \$20

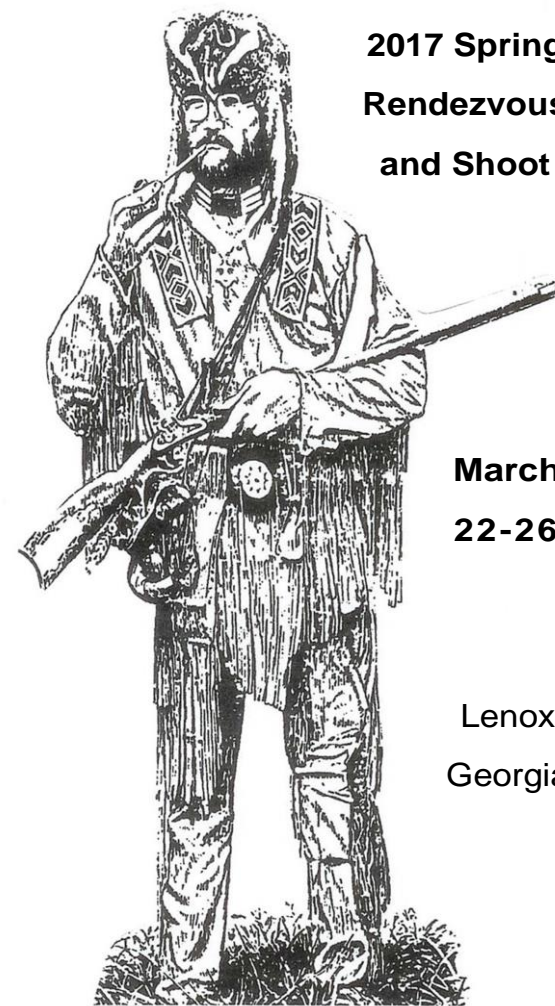
Need not be present to win and only 1 prize per person Any gun won will have to be picked-up at the club. NO SHIPPING and you must be 21years of age to win a gun.
